Eligibility Standards for Participation in MVMS INTRAMURAL & INTERSCHOLASTIC SPORTS

1. ACADEMIC PRIORITIES

All students are encouraged to participate in school sponsored activities and interscholastic athletics. However, a student must pass all of their subjects in order to participate. A review panel, chaired by the athletic director, will hear appeals from students claiming extenuating circumstances relative to athletic eligibility. **Detention, homework clubs and academic obligations take priority over intramurals and interscholastic sports.**

2. PERMISSION FORMS

The following forms must be completed to participate in any after school activity program. Please fill out, sign and return the following forms, enclosed in this booklet, to the MVMS main office or during registration, with your user fee attached to the permission forms.

- Liability Disclaimers
- Physical updated within 13 months of the activity start date on file with the nurse
- Paid User Fee - check or money orders are accepted
- Pre-Participation Concussion Form
- Online Course Concussion Form

UPDATED PHYSICAL 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

Interscholastic sports participants **must** have an updated physical **within 13 months of the activity start date on file with the school nurse. ****Please schedule a physical in advance of the sign up dates for your child if they want to play an Interscholastic sport.**

NO CLEARANCE = NO PARTICIPATION

All forms and checks are to be turned into the main office or Mr. McIntosh during Registration.

No permission forms, physical forms or checks are to be given to the coach.

MVMS REGISTRATION PROCESS & CANCELLATIONS

We are excited to announce that we are now offering the convenience of online registration through FamilyID (www.familyid.com).

FamilyID is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to register for our programs, and helps us to be more administratively efficient and environmentally responsible. When you register through FamilyID, the system keeps track of your information in your FamilyID profile. You enter your information only once for each family member for multiple uses and multiple programs.

BEFORE YOU REGISTER:

Please have an up to date physical to either upload to FamilyID or to drop off at the Athletic Office. Parents, and students, who plan to participate in any athletic program at Marblehead High School must also take a free online Concussion Education course. Two free on-line courses are available and contain all the information required by the law. The first online course is available through the National Federation of High School Coaches. You will need to click the "order here" button and complete a brief information form to register. At the end of the course, you will receive a completion receipt. The entire course, including registration, can be completed in less than 30 minutes.

The user fee is a one time fee which covers all extracurricular activities throughout the school year. Every student must pay a student activity fee before participating in any after school activity, club or sport

STATE LAW REGARDING SPORTS-RELATED HEAD INJURY & CONCUSSIONS

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Health and Human Services now requires that all schools with students **grade 6 through grade 12** who participate in **any extra curricular school sponsored athletics including Cheerleading and Marching Band** must adhere to the following law.

Student-athletes and their parents, coaches, activity leaders, athletic directors, school nurses, and physicians must learn about the consequences of head injuries and concussions through training programs and written materials. The law requires that athletes and their parents inform the school about prior head injuries at the beginning of the season. If a student athlete becomes unconscious during a game or practice, the law now mandates taking the student out of play or practice, and requires written certification from a licensed medical professional for "return to play."

Parents and students must fill out and **both** sign the **Preparticipation Head Injury Form** (see attachment) and return to their coach or activity leader.

Parents and students, who plan to participate in any athletic program grades 6-12 at Marblehead Public Schools, must also take a free online course. Two free on-line courses are available and contain all the information required by the law. The first is available through the National Federation of High School Coaches. You will need to click the "order here" button and complete a brief information form to register. At the end of the course, you will receive a completion receipt. The entire course, including registration, can be completed in less than 30 minutes.

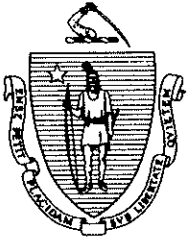
