After-School Chorus When: Mondays from 3-4pm Where: D120 We are excited to run an after-school chorus this year at MVMS! Mr. Scoglio, the MHS Chorus teacher, will direct the group. Any interested 7th or 8th-grade students are welcome to join! No previous singing experience is required, although students will be expected to attend rehearsals consistently in order to participate and perform with the chorus. The group will study various styles of vocal music, including pop music! Advisor: Mr. Scoglio

Art Club When: Tuesdays from 3-4pm Where: 301

Art Club brings together students who are interested in furthering their artistic expression. Students choose their own direction of exploration and receive instruction on their projects from the art teacher. A jazz band typically consists of saxophones, trumpets, trombones, piano, guitar, bass (string or electric), and drum set. Participation is still open to all other instruments, but students may be asked to "double" on another instrument to try something new!
