In order to be eligible, the following criteria must be met:

1. The applicant must be a female high school student who resides in a DKG member community in Essex County, Massachusetts.
2. The applicant must be pursuing a degree in education at a four-year college or university.
3. The applicant must demonstrate leadership qualities and participate in school and community activities.

One application is enclosed, but you may duplicate this for as many candidates as you have. (Please note that this is a two-sided application!)

The completed application must be postmarked and received by **April 15, 2025 – and mailed by the applicant**. Each application must be accompanied by a transcript, two letters of recommendation (one from school and one from a member of the community), and a personal essay/statement from the student. *We will look favorably upon a student who has not only achieved a good academic record, but also has contributed to their school or community.*

30 scholarships available

As many as 30 scholarships are awarded each year to members pursuing advance degrees. Scholarships for those seeking other graduate studies are \$6,000 and a doctorate is \$10,000.

- **State organizations and chapters** provided \$258,366.39 in scholarships to 750 members in 2018-2019.
- **At the international level** the Society awarded \$104,000 in scholarships for 2018-2019.
- **As of 2018-2019** the Society has awarded \$5,750,000.00 to 1,144 members since the international scholarship program began in 1940.
- **Total contributions** in 2018-2019 totaled \$134,996.65.

Who should apply?

To qualify for a scholarship at the international level, the applicant must

- **Be an active member of the Society** for a minimum of three years if pursuing doctoral studies, and be an active member of the Society for a minimum of one (1) year at the time of application if pursuing other graduate studies.
- **Have completed a bachelor's degree** or equivalent.
- **Be accepted and enrolled in a graduate program** of a nationally accredited institution of higher education, preferably pursuing a doctoral degree.
- **Provide evidence of** excellence in scholarship and service to the community.
- **Be a first-time recipient** of an international scholarship -*International Standing Rule 13.62*

How to apply

- **Complete current application form** available July 1 on Society website.
- **Request appropriate transcripts.**
- **Obtain status of program documentation.**
- **Secure letters of recommendation.**
- **Send application as an e-mail** attachment to Society Headquarters by February 1.
