The Wilhelmina Denning Jackson Art Scholarships are available to artistic young men and women who are residents of Marblehead and Swampscott (resided for two years prior to applying for the scholarship) or graduates of Marblehead or Swampscott High School.

The scholarships are for study in the arts such as painting, sculpture, graphics, printmaking, industrial design, illustration, fashion design, ceramics and art history. It does not include the study of architecture and photography.

The scholarship is awarded for a maximum of four years upon acceptance to a college or university in a degree program, and continuation of the scholarship is contingent upon maintaining a strong academic grade point average.

Applications must be received by February 15. Applications received after this date will not be accepted. This deadline enables the evaluation of applicants' portfolios and for the Scholarship Committee to interview all prospective students and reach a decision before the end of the school year.

This generous scholarship is awarded to qualified students on the basis of artistic ability, evaluation of character, work habits, and financial need. The Scholarship is awarded for a maximum of four years upon acceptance to a degree program at a college or university with an art major. It is for undergraduate work only.

Applications must be received by February 15. Applications received after this date will not be accepted. This deadline enables the Scholarship Committee to have the portfolios assessed and to interview all prospective students thereby reaching a decision before the end of the school year.

- 1. A completed application and a second copy.
- 2. An official school transcript from the current school.
- 3. Three (3) letters of recommendation. Letters should include the length of time the writer has known the applicant, and contain an evaluation of character, work habits, and if possible, artistic ability, citing a few examples. Letters should conclude with reasons for the recommendation. At least one letter must be from an art instructor at the current school.
